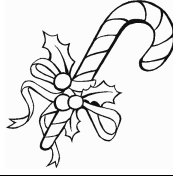
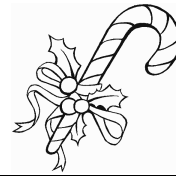

Curriculum...

-During this month the themes we will be focusing on are Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, and Christmas.

-Our developmental skills we are working on for the month of December are: Continuing with strengthening self-help skills, letter recognition and connecting beginning sounds, also continuing on focusing on developing the small motor skills, as well as challenging our beginning writing skills.

-During this month the "letter's of the week" that we will be exploring are L, M, and Letter Review: A-M. We will discuss each letter's sound and zoo phonics animal that goes with it, as well as continue to add pages to your child's Alphabet Book. For the week of Letter Review, we will be recapping on the previous letters learned through various activities.

-During this month we will continue working on challenging math concepts by exploring patterning, graphing, sorting, counting, matching and estimating through many different activities. We will also be focusing on Science through predicting and testing out an assortment of experiments with creating bouncy balls, different cooking projects, oil observations, etc.

-We will also be learning the following words in Sign Language and Spanish: candles, presents, laughter, joy, creativity, 7 principles, Christmas lights, cheer, sleigh, decorating, santa clause, etc.

If you know another language and would like to give us a lesson, we would be more than happy to include you in our circle time curriculum!

As the Weather Continues to get Cooler...

A Few Gentle Reminders...
